

# Comprehensive Planning Commission (CPC) Meeting

December 06, 2014

Ridgeville Town Hall

**MEMBERS PRESENT:** Inese Epstein, Chairman, Ron Luethe, Secretary, Andi Radke Rynes and Marcy Clark.

**NON-MEMBERS PRESENT:** None

**MEMBERS ABSENT:** Laurene Krueger

Chairperson Epstein called meeting to order. Motion to approve agenda by Andi Radke Rynes second by Marcy Clark. Motion carried. Motion to approve minutes from October 23, 2014 meeting by Marcy Clark, second by Andi Radke Rynes. Motion carried.

Chairperson Epstein stated the purpose of the meeting is to provide the Township Board with a recommendation of which local government option would best manage the transportation resources within the township and comply with Wisconsin Act 377.

Chairperson Epstein provided an overview of Implement of Husbandry Law (IOH) – Wisconsin Act 377. Chairperson Epstein and Ron Luethe provided an overview of what was discussed at the Monroe county Unit of Wisconsin Towns Association held Thursday, December 4<sup>th</sup>, 2014 concerning Husbandry Law (IOH) – Wisconsin Act 377. Chairperson Epstein has contacted the townships surrounding Ridgeville and none have decided on an option. It was noted that there is a deadline of January 15, 2015 for the local jurisdictions to select an option and notify the state. The six options were discussed. Motion by Ron Luethe, second by Andi Radke Rynes to recommend the Ridgeville Township Board select Option E – Opt In.

The reasons the Commission selected Option E:

1. Option E is the option the state highways will follow so the township roads will have the same standards as the state highways that run through the township.
2. Option E exceeds the 40-ton GVW limit set on all county roads so the township roads will not be in conflict with the county road limit.

The Commission discussed how the township will implement this option. It is recommended that a person be designated to review the application for completeness and the town patrolman review the route on the application. Motion by Andi Radke Rynes to have Inese Epstein and the town patrolman oversee the application and review process. Second by Marcy Clark. Motion carried.

Ron Luethe motion to adjourn. Marcy Clark seconded, motion passed.
