Ordinance # LR-2-12-2018

SECTION I – TITLE AND PURPOSE

This ordinance is entitled the **Town of Ridgeville Alcohol-Related License and Permit Fee Ordinance**. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a schedule of the fees for alcohol-related licenses and permits issued by the town.

SECTION II – AUTHORITY

The Town Board of the Town of Ridgeville, Monroe County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under those specific sections of ch. 125, Wis. Sates., stated next to the name of the license or permit listed in the Schedule of Fees for Alcohol-Related Licenses and Permits set forth below to establish fees for alcohol-related licenses and permits issued by the town.

SECTION III – ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, adopts the Schedule of Fees for Alcohol-Related Licenses and Permits set forth below and establishes the fees for alcohol-related licenses and permits issued by the town as stated therein.

SECTION IV – SEVERABILTY


If an provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

SECTION V – EFFECTIVE DATE


This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s.60.80, Wis.Stats



2. Class "B" Fermented Premises License	s. 125.26 (4)	\$100.00 per year
