Agenda items were reviewed. Roxie Anderson reviewed the plan Goals and Objectives and assigned individuals to begin writing the plan sections. Committee members assigned sections will be receiving an email from Roxie Anderson on the sections you are responsible for (NOTE: some sections will have more than one author assigned to that section). Bob Micheel presented a map depicting two buffer areas adjacent to the Tri-Creeks property that may be of interest to acquire the property if it would become available. He also working on the lease for the cropland within the Tri-Creek property. Some of the land adjacent to the creek will be enrolled in CREP or CRP. The cropland referred to as the “donut hole” will be taken out of production and put into pollinators and open space.
