

**TOWN OF RIDGEVILLE  
MINUTES  
SPECIAL BOARD MEETING  
March 25, 2021**

The Town of Ridgeville held a special board meeting on Thursday, March 25<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at 1:00 PM.

Those present were Chairman Keith Giraud, Supervisor Ron Luethe, Supervisor Jerry Haney, Clerk Rita Williams, and Road Patrolman Darren Martin.

The first item of business on the agenda was to discuss the details for the new plow truck we will be purchasing soon. After some discussion there was a motion from Ron Luethe and seconded by Jerry Haney to approve the purchase of the plow truck and to go ahead with the loan from the Farmers & Merchants Bank of Kendall. Motion Carried. The loan will be \$180,000.00 for 5 years at 3.75% interest.

It was also mentioned that Monroe County will have their Hazardous Clean Up on April 24<sup>th</sup>. As usual we will have our Spring Clean-Up Days on the weekend following on April 30<sup>th</sup> and May 1<sup>st</sup>.

The town board along with Road Patrolman, Darren Martin left to go to review the town roads and determine priority roads for maintenance/repair with budgeted funds that need to be taken care this year.

It was noted that Supervisor Ron Luethe will take minutes for this road assessment and turn those minutes into Clerk Williams to be added to her minutes for the first half of the meeting.

Board Members in attendance: Chairman Keith Giraud, 1<sup>st</sup> Supervisor, Ron Luethe, 2<sup>nd</sup> Supervisor Gerry Haney, Road Patrolman Darren Martin.

The purpose of the meeting was to review township roads and determine priority roads for maintenance/repair with budgeted 2021 funds.

Kingdom Avenue – 0.37 mile

Evaluate 3 culverts and replace if needed. Double seal coat; 2012 with limestone chips and second coat 2022 with granite chips.

Kennedy Avenue – 0.70 mile

Apply 4 inches of gravel. Seal coat with limestone chips in 2012 and 2022. Complete from intersection at Kendall Avenue.

Joliet Avenue – 0.20 mile

Second seal coat with limestone chips.

Jitney Avenue - .11 mile

Patch and seal coat with limestone chips.

Leapfrog – 0.08 mile

Sealcoat with limestone chips bridge approaches and road.

Kendall Avenue – Patch holes. Observed bad part. Will spread mix in area.

Kelton Avenue – 1.33 miles. Requires patching. Eventually will need a 3-inch gravel lift and seal coated.
