

Notice to All Town of Ridgeville Residents:

Effective immediately the Town of Ridgeville has passed a new policy on the costs for Fire Signs.

Fire Sign Numbers are assigned by the Monroe County Land Information Officer/GIS Coordinator.

Once a resident has been assigned a number from the County, the Town of Ridgeville is notified and we are required to order the signs through BCE Bureau of Correctional Enterprises. When we receive those signs the Town of Ridgeville will do the following:

If this is a new fire sign connected to new construction/new home and issued thru a Building Permit, the cost is taken care of through that Building Permit Issued.

If you are in need of a replacement fire sign because of damage, no longer readable, etc., the following will take place:

The Town will order a new fire sign.

- 1. We will contact the resident and find out if they want to install the sign themselves or if they wish to have the Town of Ridgeville install the fire sign.**
- 2. If you install the sign yourself your cost will be \$18.00 or the current cost of a fire sign. (The Town will bill you once we have received the sign)**
- 3. If you wish to have the Town of Ridgeville install the fire sign there will be a cost of \$100.00, which will cover the sign, the post, and the cost/time for the installation. (Again the Town will bill you when we have received the sign)**
